It will blend theory and practical board room experience through interactive session, panel discussion and group exercises.

Excellence Enablers Private Ltd. (EEPL) is organising a training programme here on March 4 for both executive, non-executives and prospective directors, to improve their performance at the board level.

The one-day programme – Developing Discerning Directors – will enable the participants to travel beyond the prescriptive framework of governance to understand issues that will have a significant bearing on their improved performance at the board level.

To ensure that the course to be a productive and participatory one, EEPL has limited the number of participants to 30 in each programme on first-come-first-served basis.

“This time, the course will include behavioural and cultural dimensions of Indian boards, board room dynamics, responsibilities of directors – a legal perspective, understanding the financial statements, board committees and expectations and addressing external perceptions,” he said.
